



Candidate Nomination Criteria

Prospective Animals Count candidates will be carefully selected by the National Officers. Specifically, candidates will need to meet the following criteria:

- Eligible for candidacy in the applicable constituency.
- A commitment to the advancement of animal issues, preferably with a demonstrable track record.
- Sufficient time (minimum of 2h a week, preferably considerably more) and resources to liaise and effectively campaign in a reliable and dependable manner and able to work to deadlines.
- Willingness and ability to work within the Animals Count team.
- Basic communication facilities e.g. mobile phone, landline, daily email and internet access.
- Highly developed oral and written communication and interpersonal skills. Media skills and experience.
- Adherence to the Constitution of Animals Count.
- Commitment to upholding the aims and reputation of the Party.
- Has been a member of Animals Count for at least one year.
- Knowledge or experience of political/legislative processes desirable.
- Minimum age: 18 years old.
- Well dressed and presentable at public functions.
- No unspent criminal convictions.
